Applications and Qualifications

Interested applicants should submit a statement of interest and CV outlining the following:

- *Credentials and Education:* Peer reviewers must be dental hygienists with a minimum of a Master's degree in dental hygiene or related field. Consideration may be given to those close to completion of a graduate degree.
- Research: a list of their published research within the last 10 years.
- Experience developing successful grant proposals
- Peer Review: experience reviewing manuscripts, grant proposals and conference abstracts.
